

Review of a Magistrates Court housing decision

What are my rights to review a Magistrates Court housing decision?

You may seek a review of a decision of the Magistrates Court in relation to a housing dispute where one party is interstate.

This right of appeal is with the District Court of South Australia.

You may make an application for review with the District Court registry. You may contact the District Court registry for further information about lodging an application by telephone **(08) 8204 2444** or by email **district.civil@courts.sa.gov.au**.

Is there a time limit to review a Magistrates Court Housing decision?

You must make an application for review with the District Court registry within 21 days of the decision you want reviewed.

Who can assist me with my application?
