About the Homelessness Sector

People who are homeless or have high support needs require extra help to find the right housing solution that delivers stability, quality of life and a sense of security and connectedness.

The Government partners with other agencies to provide supported accommodation services for:

- Young people;
- Families;
- Single adults;
- Those experiencing domestic violence.

Gateway Services

Gateway services are telephone-based support services operating 24/7 which ensure clients are assessed and referred to an appropriate service for their needs.
